

Gwaith Cartref Tymor yr Haf 2026

Blwyddyn 1 a 2



Ein thema am y tymor yma yw 'Dere i Dyfu.' Dros y tymor byddwn yn casglu'r gwaith cartref er mwyn dathlu'ch gwaith a'u gosod yn y dosbarth.

Dyma restr o syniadau ar gyfer gweithgareddau gwahanol gallwch gwblhau.

Cofiwch, mae'r rhestr yn ddiddiwedd!

- Ysgrifennwch fersiwn newydd o Jac a'r goeden ffa ond ar lan y môr (e.e. ffa hud yn tyfu allan o'r tywod).
- Casglwch gregyn (neu lluniwch rai) a'u trefnu yn grwpiau o 2, 5 neu 10. Cymharwch taldra y "goeden ffa" (tynnu llun) gyda gwrthrychau eraill.
- Plannwch ffa mewn pot bach a chadwch ddyddiadur twf—sut mae'n tyfu fel yn stori Jac? Beth sydd ei angen ar blanhigion i dyfu?
- Creu "antur Jac": dringo (yn ddiogel), neidio fel tonnau'r môr, a symud fel cewri. Trafodwch sut mae symud yn helpu'r corff.
- Gwnewch goeden ffa enfawr gyda phapur, lliwiau, neu ddeunyddiau naturiol fel tywod a chregyn.
- Tynnwch fap o'r traeth a lle mae'r goeden ffa hud yn tyfu. Ychwanegwch nodweddion fel y môr, creigiau, a chestyll tywod.
- Actiwch olygfa o'r stori ond ar lan y môr—pwy yw'r cawr? Ble mae'r castell - efallai ar gwmwl dros y môr?
- Defnyddiwch gregyn neu liwiau i greu patrymau (e.e. coch, glas, coch, glas) fel tonnau'r môr.
- Dysgwch am anifeiliaid y môr—pa rai allai Jac weld wrth ddringo'r goeden ffa ger y traeth?
- Creu cân neu rhythm am Jac, y môr, a'r goeden ffa, a symud i'r gerddoriaeth fel tonnau.
- Ymarfer eich llawysgrifen.
- Darllen eich llyfrau unigol.

Anogwn eich bod yn dod a'ch darnau o waith i'r ysgol yn syth ar ôl cwblhau.

Summer Term Homework 2026

Year 1 and 2



Our theme this term is 'Let's Grow.' During the term we will be collecting homework in order to celebrate the children's work which will be displayed in our classrooms.

Here is a list of ideas of activities you could complete. Remember, the list is endless!

- Write a new version of Jack and the Beanstalk set at the seaside (e.g. a magic bean growing out of the sand).
- Collect shells (or draw some) and group them into 2s, 5s, or 10s. Compare the height of the beanstalk (draw it) with other objects.
- Plant a bean in a small pot and keep a growth diary—how does it grow like in Jack's story? What do plants need to grow?
- Create a "Jack adventure": climb (safely), jump like waves, and move like giants. Talk about how movement helps the body.
- Make a giant beanstalk using paper, colours, or natural materials like sand and shells.
- Draw a map of the beach and where the magic beanstalk grows. Add features like the sea, rocks, and sandcastles.
- Act out a scene from the story at the seaside—who is the giant? Where is the castle (maybe on a cloud above the sea)?
- Use shells or colours to create patterns (e.g. red, blue, red, blue) like ocean waves.
- Learn about sea animals—what might Jack see while climbing a beanstalk near the beach?
- Create a song or rhythm about Jack, the sea, and the beanstalk, and move like waves to the music.
- Practise your handwriting.
- Read your individual reading books.

We encourage you to bring your work into school as soon as it's ready.
